- INSURANCE FOREIGN COMPETITOR IS COMPULSARY AND COSTS € 7,00 PER DAY . The Dutch competitors needs a KNMV basis sportlicentie 2017.
- WEARING A HELMET IS COMPULSARY !
- OIL DRIP FLOOR MAT under the motorcycle in the paddock is COMPULSARY !
- No trial riding at the parking place, only on the trial track.
- Each lap has a length of about 2 km.
  De competitors of the white, blue, blue+ track and the sidecars have to make 3 laps, each lap containing 8 sections.
  De competitors of the red, yellow and yellow+ track have to make 4 laps, each lap containing 8 sections.
- Every competitor has to sign in before the start and obtain a new punchcard every lap.
- Before the start the motorcycles will be scrutineered by an official, who looks for safety, class and extreme noise.
- On **Saturday** trial you will compete for a classification in the "Eurocup" and for the Dutch for "CTN" (Classic Trial Nederland)

On **Sunday** trial you will compete for a day result and for the Dutch for "CTN" (Classic Trial Nederland).

- No Standing still and riding backwards and no sideway's "JUMPING" without foreward movement.
- You have to follow only the coloured signs which are valid for the track which you have chosen.
- Further the trial will be held according to international rules.
- The trials on Saturday and Sunday will be rewarded separately.
- Prices: 1) Every competitor receives a vane.
  - 2) Each first qualified rider per class per track colour, receives an award.

We would very much appreciate the fact that your motorbike is build according to the following rules:

- 1. The motorbikes must meet the demands of their class (See entryform).
- 2. Motorbikes must look like those in the old days.
- 3. Mainframe and engine must be original or replica.
- 4. Bikes must have drum-brakes and a construction of the front-axle as original.
- 5. Max groundclearance of 26 cm (unloaded)
- 6. Tyres, rims, carburators, ignition, handlebars etc, free choise.
- 7. Exotic materials such as titanium, carbonfiber and so on are not allowed.
